How would you describe your business?

Sea Life Park is celebrating 60 years of marine life conservation, education and care in Hawai'i. Located in East Oʻahu, it is Hawai'i's premier marine park home to Hawaiian green sea turtles, Hawaiian monk seals, California sea lions, reef sharks, bottlenose dolphins, Humboldt penguins and more.

What are some of your most popular activities?

The most popular activities within the park would be our animal encounters. We provide a safe and controlled environment for guests to get up close and personal with either bottlenose dolphins, sea lions, or reef sharks and tropical fish. Our Dolphin Aloha program allows participants ages 1 and older to stand next to our habitat pool to see, touch and interact with bottlenose dolphins. Our Dolphin Encounter or Dolphin Exploration activities allow guests to get into the habitat pool and interact with our dolphins for a truly memorable experience. Our shark snorkel allows guests to swim with small reef sharks and to feed tropical fish. Our sea lion encounters allow guests to interact and learn more about California sea lions.

What can guests expect?

Guests can expect to learn more about Hawai'i's marine life, especially the efforts of Sea Life Park to promote conservation, education, and care for all marine life. The park hosts daily educational talks for the entire family to learn more about our marine life. We also have cultural activities on monthly rotation allowing guests to participate in *kapa* making, or creating "*limu lei*," a unique partnership with Waimānalo Limu Hui in an effort to grow and replant native seaweed used for cooking and medicinal purposes.

Who is this activity ideal for?

Sea Life Park is the perfect attraction for all families wanting to create special memories together during their time on Oʻahu. From the scenic drive out to East Oʻahu around Makapuʻu Beach with views of Mānana Island and the historic Makapuʻu Lighthouse, to seeing the care provided to our rescued animals, as well as meeting our Hawaiian green sea turtles or Hawaiian monk seals, it's sure to make for a very special visit.
